

Instructions for Construction Volunteers

Construction takes place 12 months a year, Tuesday –Thursday and Saturday,
8:45am – 4:00pm, rain or shine! On Tuesdays, please report 1 hour later, i.e. 9:45am!

[Everyone gathers for morning orientation and then moves to a specific job/task.
Due to weather and delivery of materials, we cannot guarantee specific assignment in advance.]

Please Be On Time!

8:45 am Park on the street near 19 Grape Street (see attached map). Go to the Habitat sign-in area.
(Meeting and sign-in location will be provided prior to your scheduled volunteer date)
Find the Habitat Construction Supervisors. Sign-in and create a name badge. If necessary,
call one of our construction supervisors: Erwin Mageary—370-3654 or Edwin Mageary— 370-4900

(Flower City Habitat carries secondary insurance coverage for construction
volunteers. However, to be covered, volunteers must sign-in each time they come!)

9:00 – 9:10am Habitat Construction Supervisors provide orientation, safety tips, morning
prayer. Supervisors assign work and locations. Proceed to assigned location.

9:15am Begin work

12 Noon LUNCH & REST

12:30pm Resume work

3:00 – 3:30pm Clean up and secure site for the night
3:45 -- 4:00pm Closing remarks - Please complete a feedback form
Supervisor thanks and distribution of membership information
There is a mid-morning and a mid-afternoon break

ALL WORKERS:

- x Wear hard-soled work shoes or hiking boots. Sneakers and sandals are not permitted.
- x Wear “work clothes”and dress for the weather. Expect to work outdoors.
- x A hat and sunscreen are suggested for hot weather.
- x Tools, training, and safety equipment are provided
- x OPTIONAL: You may find it more comfortable to bring personal work items such as

- gloves, safety glasses, tool apron, hammer, tape measure, pencil, and a utility knife
- x Bring a bag lunch; drinking water and ice are provided.
- x A portable toilet is on site (a hand sanitizer or wipes are nice).
- x Secure valuables out of sight, e.g. in a locked car trunk or carry them in a waist pouch.
- x Avoid wearing jewelry; it can get lost.

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FOR GROUPS:

Do not bring more than six (6) volunteers

If you expect fewer, kindly notify the Volunteer Coordinator so we can fill those slots.

Please designate one person as “Group Leader” and have them call/email the VC.
